The cities of Scottsbluff, Gering and Terrytown are home to a dynamic range of telecommunications providers. The telecommuni-

cation companies include two landline telephone carriers, three cellular carriers and several internet service providers offering cable, DSL and wireless broadband solutions.

Mass media communication services blanket the area. The **Star-Herald** is a local daily newspaper. There are three weekly papers - the **Business Farmer**, the **Gering Citizen** and the **Gering Courier**. Other daily papers that are delivered in the region include the USA Today.

The ABC network affiliation is provided by Duhamel Broadcasting Enterprises who owns **KOTA Territory** television. Sagamore Hill Broadcasting, who owns **KSTF television**, provides the CBS network affiliations to the area.
